## **EMISSIONS STANDARDS CODE**

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#### 1 Introduction

- 1.1 Singapore has committed to achieve net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050. To support this national target, the power sector which accounts for 40% of Singapore's carbon emissions and currently generates 95% of electricity from natural gas must undergo progressive decarbonisation.
- 1.2 In 2023, EMA consulted industry on the proposed Emissions Standards for the power sector. Feedback received from the consultation process recognised the need for emissions standards. After careful consideration of the feedback received, EMA issued the Final Determination Paper in October 2023, establishing the emissions standards for new and repowered fossil fuel-fired generation units. The emission standards will be enforced through a new Code of Practice the Emissions Standards Code ("Code") as set out in the Annex 1.
- 1.3 The Code sets out the standards and procedures that Generation Licensees shall comply with in electricity generation activities. The Code also set outs the rights, obligations, and technical requirements for Generation Licensees in achieving and maintaining the prescribed emissions standards. This includes the compliance requirements, exemption conditions, hydrogen-readiness requirements, as well as the measurement and reporting requirements.
- 1.4 EMA will continue to review and gradually tighten the emissions standards over time to ensure the power sector is on track to facilitate the transition to net zero emissions by 2050. EMA will consult the industry before doing so.
